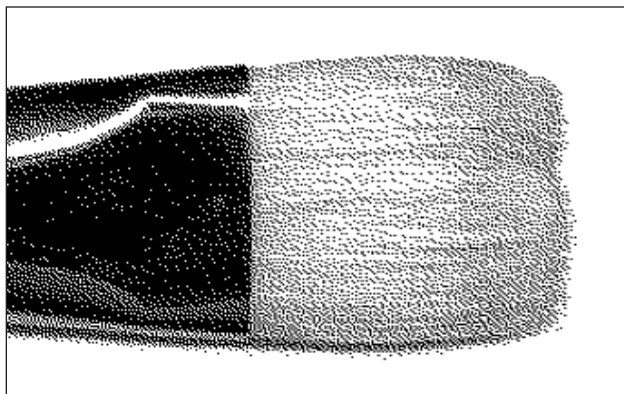
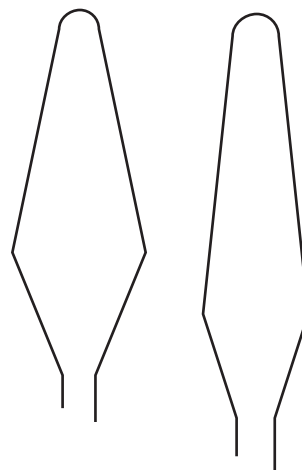

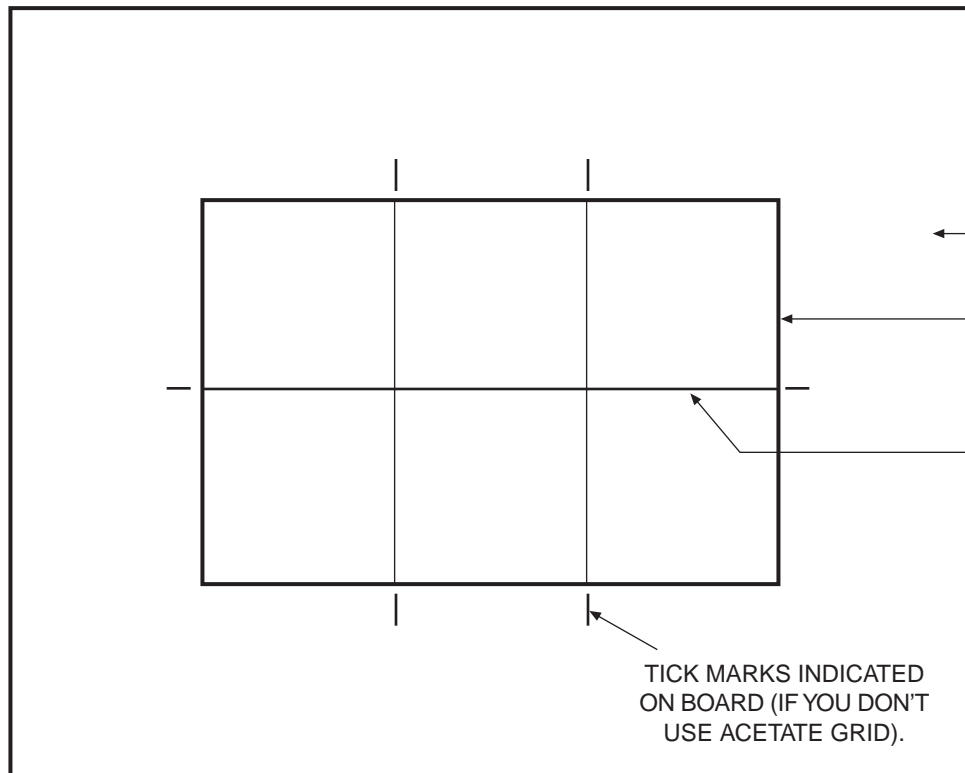


PALETTE KNIFE



A metal palette knife with either of these type heads will be fine.

VIEWFINDER



MATTE BOARD

2 X 3 OPENING

TICK MARKS INDICATED
ON BOARD (IF YOU DON'T
USE ACETATE GRID).



A viewfinder makes selecting a composition easier. You can easily make your own like the one shown here.

With scrap matte board, simply cut out a 5 x 4 piece; then cut a 2 x 3 opening.

For a viewfinder with an added grid pattern: draw out a 1 inch grid on acetate (clear plastic), and then tape that piece of acetate to the back of the viewfinder. Or simply draw tick marks on the cardboard that correspond to the inch grid

A PLASTIC BOTTLE with this type of spout is ideal for solvents. A small 2 – 3 in. plastic funnel is also very helpful for puring the solvent into the bottle.
